
EGRPS Parent Tech Update

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East Grand Rapids Middle School Innovation Lab

During the summer of 2016, a room that was formerly home to the middle school shop received a high tech makeover. Renamed the Innovation lab, this space has the latest technology focused on inspiring student learning. Teacher Kevin Vance assisted in the redesign of the space and has taught the first few classes in the space shares: "The Innovation Lab has allowed students to have creative freedom to explore new technologies such as littleBits, Arduino, Raspberry Pi, and Robotics and create unique projects using these tools. The students also have shown great collaboration when working together in teams and also when teaching other students how to use a technology that they have become an expert with. Perhaps the most important thing that I have witnessed is students embracing failure and not giving up on a project even though it may be difficult and problematic at times."

District Device Request Window Open

Engage 1:1 is a voluntary and encouraged technology program which supports the learning of middle school and high school students in East Grand Rapids. Students are encouraged to bring their own technology device, or they may join the District-Provided Device program. As part of the Engage 1:1 program we offer an option for families who are unable to provide a personal device for their student(s) to secure a District-Provided Device. Students accepted into this program will be provided with a district-owned technology device to use during the 2017-2018 school year. Interested families with students who will be in grades 6-12 during the 2017-2018 school year may submit an application for consideration. The application deadline is Friday, May 5, 2017, and families will receive notification of their acceptance status by Friday, June 2, 2017.
